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Achievements:

1. School got affiliated to C.B.S.E., New Delhi upto Secondary Level.
2. School infrastructure development for upgradation upto Senior secondary level has been on warfooting.

Challenges:

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Achievements:

1. Mr. Shivam Kumar from School got selected for admission to Simultala Avasiya Vidyalaya, Jamui in Class VI and is placed within 15 position at state level in 1st Merit List published by Bihar State Government. The examination was conducted at state level for selecting 60 students for admission in the state.
2. More than 55 students from different classes attended and placed in good ranks at state and international level in the examination conducted by Science Olympiad Foundation, New Delhi.
3. 3 students from Brilliant Public School from Class VIII of 5 students from the sitamarhi district qualified for the 2nd stage of N.T.S.E.-2012 at the state level.
4. Mr. Adnan Khurram got selected for Inspird Award at the state level and received consolation prize at National Level.

Challenges:

1. Parent's involvement in monitoring the academic activities of their ward is not satisfactory. School instruction follow up is not proper. Few Parents don't pay school fee dues for months together thereby causing delay of payment to teachers unnecessarily.
2. Parent don't pay attention to their ward school dress conditions.
3. They provide prohibited items such as mobiles, valuable items like gold, costly watches etc. to their ward.
4. Student's involvement in local functions at their home at the consent of their guardian disrupt the continuity of study.
