Here is the 6th Annual report for the year 2012-13.

I am proud to announce that previous six years have been very exciting and rewarding for the school in terms of annual results and the performances in other extra-curricular activities. As you are aware, the school education is the priority agenda of the Central Government and the Ministry of Education is constantly under scoring the professionalization of education enabling the youth of the country to become entrepreneurs by taking up self-employment assignments. CBSE, to which this school is affiliated, is constantly stressing us to innovate and diversify our efforts to hammer out the best stuff for the country's development.

It gives me immense pleasure to inform you that our school staff and the management is fine tuned to the guidelines of the CBSE and the government to give ample exposure in modern day challenges to the students In line with these guide-lines, we lay considerable stress on extra-curricular activities. The students are being exposed to the latest pedagogy patterns by inviting educationists to deliver lectures to the senior class students. We have adopted a fixed pattern to arrange series of lectures, debates, declamations. Quiz competitions, spot painting contests apart from sports activities to make the students mentally and physically active and fit.

Our commitment has been to ensure the overall holistic development of our students, thereby in addition to all our efforts to impart the best education; we also provide equal importance to extracurricular activities like sports, physical education, self-development etc. Now we have our website – www.brilliantpublicschool.com. Before embarking upon the performance of the school during the years under review, I may like to refresh your memories about the origin of this big institution. The school is the brain child of its Founder Director Er. Brahma Dev Sah, a successful engineer by profession, who earned a reputation for his excellent managerial skills and high ethical values. Throughout his illustrious career, he has given high priority to social issues and concerns. Mr. Sah is an Engineering graduate from "Indian School Of Mines", Dhanbad(1967).

He served the mining industry and taken up various prestigious posts during his thirty four years long career. He was in-charge of Gevra Project, the biggest coal mine in South East Asia. Before retirement, he was in charge of Coal Controller Organizations under the Ministry of Coal for three states- Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, and Chhatisgarh.

He retired as G.M. from Coal India Ltd. in year 2004. While functioning as general manager at different locations in Coal India Ltd., Mr. Sah had the privilege to be the President / Chairman of different D.A.V. schools and central schools. As a result of this, he got to observe and interact with different education systems.

After retirement, he thought of sharing his valuable, experiences and knowledge with society and started guiding and counselling for Engg. and Medical entrance exams aspirants. In continuation to this, he started Brilliant Public School, an educational institute with a difference and sole motto of providing quality education to all.

The school was started in 2007 in a private building as a joint family effort. We were lucky to have about 250 students in the first year. The strength went on increasing due to missionary zeal which the management put behind it. It was affiliated to the CBSE in 2012 after which it is going from strength to strength. Now the school strength is 830 plus. We have a fleet of buses to transport students from distant places.

We have following sections:

I. Primary Section: - Nursery to Std. II

The Children are taught spoken English and Numerals. Talents in the fields of Art, Craft, Music, Singing and Dramatics are developed. To improve the psychomotor domain, children are exposed to various activities such as plasticine moulding, paper folding, fitting block to insects etc. The foundation for good handwriting is laid here. The child is exposed to the experience of interacting in a peer group.

II. Junior Section: - Std. III to Std. V

These sections help the children to develop their all-round personality. In the classroom, the child is encouraged to understand rather than to memorize, to enjoy learning, to think independently and logically and to develop good study habits. The subjects taught include English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Science, Social Science, Computer Science, Moral Science, etc.

III. Senior Section: - Std. VI to Std. X

At this level, students are prepared for higher learning. Here the emphasis is laid on providing a strong foundation in subjects such as English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Science, Social Science, Computer Science, Moral Science, etc. as per the C.B.S.E. Curriculum.

C.B.S.E Curriculum:

The school is affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) New Delhi. The medium of instruction is English with due weightage to Hindi.

The school pursues the study curriculum as per the C.B.S.E. guidelines throughout the academic here with well-structured break-up of syllabus which is provided to each student and the faculties with strong follow up by school managing committee.

INFRASTRUCTURE:- The school has a sprawling area comprising more than 2.5 acres of land, as you see, in attractive environment without any hassles of traffic, noise pollution or any kind of threat to the safety of the students. The school building which comprises about 40 rooms and four toilet blocks was initiated in 2011 and was completed in 2013. Top floor was constructed this year which is being used as Multipurpose Hall.

We have well equipped Chemistry, Physics and Bio. Labs which are upgraded year after year in line with the syllabus. To supplement the studies, we have huge Library comprising more than 6000 books which get stocked regularly with the latest editions. Each class has been allocated library period in the time table to inculcate reading habits.

Most sought after facility is the Computer Lab which has more than two dozen latest systems with internet facilities. The Computer education has been compulsory from Std. I. It is really a treat to watch the tiny tots fiddling with the Computer with excitement. We don't mind breakages so long as small children take interest in Computer education.

We have introduced Smart Classes on an experimental basis as an aid of learning on the audio-video theory of learning. All the classes from Pre Primary to X have since been introduced to this facility. We are still on the lookout to get more effective IT methodology to make class rooms more interactive.

As a part of new scheme of pedagogy, we have a plan to start Music Academy as a part of the regular schooling with syllabus of professional courses to be affiliated to the renowned University. To facilitate local students especially girls to take to music, school has acquired examination center where all students including private can appear.

On the academic side, we have trained teachers well diversified in the field of education with a capability to mentor the students to make them a true citizen of India.

Text Books:

N.C.E.R.T. Books and other standard books are selected which provides the students a good practice and learning according the C.B.S.E., New Delhi Guidelines.

The list of books & stationary is given for each class at the time of admission.

Faculties & Staff:

Teachers form the backbone of any institution and BPS realizes this fully. We have dedicated and learned faculty of outstanding caliber and academic credentials. We take pride of our best teaching faculty and excellent student-teacher ratio.

Teachers develop close relationships with children and are loved as much as their own kith and kin! A quiet respect - not fear - is the emotion that teachers seek to inspire in their students.

Teaching Methodology

We believe that a nation is built in its educational institutions. The object of teaching a child is to enable him to act independently with confidence and unfold his capabilities to learn with interest.

Stress is laid on giving individual attention to each student for class room study and to complete homework assignment in the school itself in extra class to avoid private tuition.

At B.P.S., each section is of 30-40 students and efforts are made to provide enough stimuli and cultivation of mind and not mere cramming of books for examination.

Competitive Environment:

In line with the approach adopted by the CBSE at the instance of the Central Govt. to give maximum exposure to the students at the school level, we have initiated maximum students various types of All India Competitions. Our students took part in the following competitions:-

All India Mathematics Olympiad

All India English Olympiad

All India Science Olympiad

All India National Talent Search Examination

The school is registered with Science Olympiad Foundation (S.O.F.), New Delhi, for the year 2012-13 with 156 students participating in Maths, Science and English Olympiads.

45 students qualified for the Level-II examination in the year 2012 conducted by Science Olympiad Foundation, New Delhi for this year to prove their talent at International Level.

Smart Learning/ E-learning Classes:

Recently the school has started Audio-Visual Classes as new initiative to provide better understanding of the subject topic where the animated visuals make the students learn in better way in short time. It covers the students from Std. I to X for Science, Mathematics, Social Science and English.

Co-Curricular activities:

Co-curricular activities are those activities which are in addition to classroom instruction and do not result in a grade nor credit. Any activity for which a grade is issued is not considered a co-curricular activity. The Co-Curricular activities are enforced for all students whenever they are acting as a representative of the school (e.g. practices, games, trips, camps and tours, etc.).

These activities facilitate the all-round development of children. Cultural programs, sports, community service, etc. are the examples of C.C.A. These activities, not only, strengthens the subject matter, they also nourish students' attitude, interest and personality.

Besides academics, Inter-house activities are planned to instill a spirit of competition. Among these activities are Elocution, Debate, Quiz, Dramatics, Painting, Creative writing, Vocal and Instrumented Music, Art & craft, paper flower making, needle work etc.

Awards & Honours:

Students excelling in studies and/or games other competitions are awarded / honoured at frequent occasions during the academic session to keep them motivated.

The details of winners in various extra-curricular activities are posted regularly on the school website. It can be referred from the website for winners and team members for various functions organized on regular basis.

We are lucky to have vast ground as per C.B.S.E. norms for major games like football, hockey, cricket etc. We have adopted football as a major game and basketball, kho-kho, Badminton, Table tennis and Volley Ball as minor games. Our boys are regular player of District and State teams in Football.

We are happy to inform you that we have upgraded our infrastructure including our computer lab, Science lab and Library.

Club Activities:

We have various club constituted to give the all-round exposure to our students by our well trained faculties. The details of their activities can be referred from our school website with winners and team members with the various functions organized on regular basis.

The school is meticulously following the practice of teacher-parents monthly meetings to discuss the problems of the students, This practice has helped us in assessing the areas of strength and

Our Management has a weekly meeting with all the teachers to review the activities of our school and plan the future. The syllabus and books have been revised to ensure that the students have the updated curriculum.

Our school management has given concession to 145 students which amount to approximately over two lakhs rupees.

Brilliant Public School family comprises of 45 teaching staff, 7 Non-teaching staff and 10 drivers. All our staff members are well qualified and experienced in their respective field to take care for the children.

We have Nine school buses to pick up and drop our children safely to school and back home.
